Our Purpose:

The Hills Sports High School provides both a comprehensive secondary education and a focused sports development program for students in Western Sydney. Greater than half of the total enrolment of 950 students attend in order to foster their elite sporting talents whilst completing their secondary education in an academic framework.

Position:

The Hills Sports High School seeks to engage a dynamic Australian Football coach with a strong practical knowledge of Australian Football, coaching and development to work closely with school, staff and the Australian Football teacher mentor in developing a comprehensive and progressive school Australian Football program.

Australian Football sessions are conducted Tuesday and Thursday (8.30am-10.30am) during school hours (4 hours per week – more with matches/gala days)

Rates of pay will be commensurate to coaching experience and accreditation.

Length of role – Start in April, 2024.

Core Duties and Responsibilities

- Run Australian Football sessions in collaboration with school staff.
- Implement a consistent and appropriate training schedule and structure across the program that will facilitate development into senior Football and representative pathways.
- Individual feedback (verbal and written) to the players on their progress during the semester, highlighting areas of strength and areas for future development.
- Provide guidance, insight, and input to students for them to take into consideration in regards to the selection of match squads and school teams.
